Re: SB 797 - Courts and Judicial Proceedings-Witnesses-Privileged Communications  
Between Labor Organization and Member - **OPPOSE**

Dear Senator Frosh:

This bill would prohibit a labor organization or an agent thereof from being compelled to disclose any communication an agent of the organization acquired from a member in the course of the agent's duties or while acting in the agent's representative capacity. This bill would extend attorney client privilege to a labor organization and its members that they are not entitled to assume. This bill would also interfere with federal law which regulates the rights and responsibilities of employees and their representatives through the NLRA.

For these reasons above, The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce asks that your committee give this bill an unfavorable report.
