RE: SB 464 – County Transfer Tax – Collection - **Oppose**

Dear Senator Kasemeyer:

This bill would authorize a county to enact a law to directly collect county transfer taxes. Under current law the clerk of court collects transfer taxes on deeds recorded in the land records, and SDAT collects such taxes on instruments of writing recorded with the Department. Each state agency deducts the cost of collection prior to remitting the county taxes

The Legislative Committee of the Carroll County Chamber of Commerce opposes SB 464 as a bill that would increase the complexity in the tax collection process and in turn business transition issues.

We fail to see the reason for this administrative change and believe the current system of collections is properly performed at the local level. The county would still have to maintain records in order to know the correct amount of collections that is due. This would result in a delay in regard to receiving the funds which is unnecessary under the current system.

For these reasons, we ask that your committee give SB 464 an unfavorable report.
