**RE: HB** 934 – Income Tax – Elimination of the Marriage Penalty – **Support** 

Dear Delegate Kaiser:

House Bill 934 would correct state income tax brackets for taxpayers filing joint tax returns beginning after December 31, 2016

House Bill 934 expands the tax bracket to eliminate a built in "marriage penalty" by increasing the bracket thresholds. Current tax brackets are more favorable to single taxpayers as compared to married ones. The Legislative Committee of the Carroll County Chamber of Commerce supports this bill. We believe the bill is a step in the right direction towards fostering a more attractive climate for business and individuals in our state.

The state of Maryland is at a critical juncture as the competition to attract new business and individuals is increasing. We have seen tax and fee increases over the past years. Moreover, the move toward increased regulation has had a negative impact on our business climate. We need to reverse this cycle for the future generations of Marylanders or we continue to lose both residents and businesses and at the same time become unattractive to those who are looking at our state as a place to call home.
