RE: HB 0043 – Income Tax – Subtraction Modification – Perpetual Conservation Easements – **Support**

Dear Delegate Kaiser:

House Bill 0043 provides a subtraction modification under the Maryland income tax for the first \$100,000 in proceeds from the sale of a perpetual conservation easement on real property in the State (for example: a MALPF or Rural Legacy easement) to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 2017.
