**Re: SB 165 –** Income Tax – Flat Tax – **Support** 

Dear Senator Kasemeyer:

Senate Bill 0165 altering the State income tax rate to 3.9% for individuals with Maryland taxable income in excess of \$30,000; and applying the Act to taxable year beginning after December 31, 2018, is a good bill and deserves our support.

The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce, a business advocacy organization of over 600 members, supports this bill as it simplifies the current Maryland Income Tax Code and makes the State more competitive with our adjacent neighboring States. For your reference; Pennsylvania's tax rate is 3.07%, Virginia's is 2% and Delaware's is 2.2% at the comparative income levels for their residents.

The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce requests that you give this bill a favorable report.
