Dear Delegate Davis:

House Bill 1095 clarifying the term of a certain director of a corporation elected to fill a vacancy; altering the authority of and circumstances in which certain holders of stock may take certain action or consent to a certain action by delivering a consent in writing or by electronic transmission; altering a certain voting process of stockholders of different classes; clarifying the time by which a parent corporation is required to provide a certain notice in a certain merger; etc.

The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce, a business advocacy organization of over 600 members, opposes this bill as it oversteps the oversight of the typical private corporation bylaws which is a matter handled by each individual corporate entity. Such provisions should and are outlined within the required documents when governing the operation of a private business.

The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce requests that you give this bill an unfavorable report.
