Re: HB 1322 – Corporate Income Tax - Federal Repatriation Holiday – Support

House Bill 1322 would provide corporations who receive dividend payments from foreign subsidiaries a State subtraction modification if a Federal repatriation holiday is approved.

The Legislative Committee of the Carroll County Chamber of Commerce supports this bill as we believe it will encourage business development and encourage businesses to remain in the State of Maryland.

We believe House Bill 1322 is a step in the right direction towards fostering a more attractive climate for business in our state. This is especially true when nearby states having more favorable tax rules.
