This bill will assist counties and municipalities by increasing the portion of highway user revenues that is distributed to local governments if the Transportation Trust Fund revenue for a fiscal year exceeds the most recent estimate of the Board of Revenue Estimates for the fiscal year. By altering the allocation of the local share of highway user revenues among entities including Baltimore City, counties, and municipalities.
