**RE: SB 0252 – Railroad Company - Movement of Freight - Required Crew – Oppose**

Dear Senator Kelley:

Senate Bill 0252 prohibits a train or light engine used to move freight from being operated in the state unless it has at least two crew members, establishing penalties for specified violations, and prohibiting a county from enacting and enforcing more stringent measures.

Maryland is a state critical to the movement of freight along the entire eastern seaboard, and this requirement poses an undue hardship on railroad companies for obvious reasons. A train hauling freight would need to stop to pick up another crew member whether it is a long or a short haul just to satisfy our state requirement even though other states have no such requirement. This seems to be a solution looking for a problem. Again, this does not make Maryland appear to be a business friendly state.

The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce, a business advocacy organization of over 600 members, opposes this bill and asks that you give it an unfavorable report
