RE: HB 1333 – Labor and Employment - Wage Payment and Collection - General Contractor Liability – Support

Dear Delegate Healey:

The current law imposes liability upon a general contractor to pay the wages of a subcontractor's employee if the subcontractor does not pay the employee.

HB 1333 would require the employee to notify the general contractor within 90 days of the violation of the Wage Payment and Collection law by the subcontractor and gives the general contractor 30 days after receipt of notice to cure any such violation.

The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce, a business advocacy organization of over 600 members, supports this bill. This bill provides a measure of procedural fairness to the general contractor in dealing with such liability.

The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce requests that your committee give this bill a favorable report.
