HB 1202 prohibits the use of facial recognition software during employment interviews unless the applicant consents via a signed waiver. We are curious as to what problem this bill is proposing to solve? Is there widespread use by employers using facial recognition software in any aspect of the employment relationship?

This seems to be a wholly unnecessary effort and the Carroll County Chamber of Commerce, a business advocacy organization of over 600 members, opposes this bill. We therefore request that you give this bill an unfavorable report.
