**RE: HB 0268 - Property Tax – Exemptions for Business Personal Property – Alterations

Dear Delegate Atterbeary:

The change proposed by HB 0268 would help sole proprietors in Maryland by reducing compliance requirements of filing personal property returns for non-charter businesses with under \$20,000 of tangible personal property.

Generally, the cost to file these returns is another hurdle for home-based businesses that is unnecessary and does not result in significant revenue for the state.

The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce, a business advocacy organization of over 680 members, supports this bill. We therefore request that you give this bill a favorable report.
