RE: SB 0828 - Family and Medical Leave Insurance Program - Modifications - **Oppose**

Dear Senator Griffith:

The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce opposed the passage of the bill first establishing this program for many reasons – not the least of which was that it was being passed without having established key provisions – such as contribution amount and rate of contribution of either employer or employee.

SB 828 offers some relief to those issues, but still leaves the contribution amount unknown. Furthermore, this bill also calls for prohibiting the employer from requiring the use of other paid leave before use of this leave (in contrast to the Federal FMLA); and significantly broadens the definition of covered family member. These items will greatly increase businesses' liability under this program.

While the community provider community is sure to be quite pleased that their contributions to the program will be covered by the State, that then leaves all other businesses responsible for not only paying for an unwanted program, but making up the difference now *not* being paid by a large group of businesses and many of their employees.

Finally, since the legislature has not yet worked out all the details, it is difficult to impossible for employers to prepare for its implementation.

The Carroll County Chamber of Commerce, a business advocacy organization of over 700 members, opposes this bill and therefore requests that you give it an unfavorable report.
